


### ChildLife to Establish Largest Pediatric ER in Multan

ChildLife is establishing its largest pediatric Emergency Room (ER) at The Children's Hospital, Multan. The state-of-the-art facility, scheduled to be operational by the end of this year, spans **20,000 sq. ft**. This **100-bed ER** is poised to serve the most vulnerable and underprivileged children of South Punjab.

Pakistan currently witnesses a high child mortality rate that can be reduced by 50% if emergency services are improved. South Punjab, home to a population of over 40 million, holds immense potential for development, and bolstering social infrastructure can significantly contribute to its progress.

Multan, the largest city in South Punjab, will benefit from ChildLife's new ER, offering **free-of-charge** and **24/7** access to quality emergency care to an estimated **150,000 children** annually. The establishment of the largest children's ER in Multan marks a significant milestone in ChildLife's mission to safeguard the future of Pakistan's children.



# ChildLife extends its Emergency Care Network to all Districts of Punjab

ChildLife has reached the milestone of expanding its children's emergency care network to all districts of Punjab by establishing Telemedicine Satellite Centers in **50+** secondary care public hospitals.

Now the children living in far-flung areas of Punjab can have access to quality emergency care close to their homes. ChildLife's doctors are available round-the-clock, offering expert consultations remotely to onground medical staff for providing quality treatment to the children coming to any district hospital across Punjab.

Together, we can transform children's emergency care across Pakistan.

# SAVING CHILDREN

Alhamdulillah, ChildLife has scaled its emergency care network of children's Emergency Rooms (ER) and Telemedicine Satellite Centers (TSC) across 200+ public hospitals of Pakistan.

Over two-thirds of Pakistan's population resides in rural regions. Children from these regions are forced to travel to urban centers for proper treatment. This not only results in the loss of precious time but also entails out-of-pocket expenses for transportation and living for the poor people.

To address this issue, ChildLife has expanded its Telemedicine network by establishing Telemedicine Satellite Centers in all tehsils of Sindh, all districts of Balochistan and Punjab. Now the children living in these areas have access to quality emergency care close to their homes, 24/7 and freeof-charge.
