FIRST TIME IN PAKISTAN PEDIATRIC EMERGENCY MEDICINE CERTIFICATION OF NURSING

ChildLife Foundation conducted the “First Pediatric Emergency Medicine Certificate of Nursing” in Pakistan. In this program, 73 nurses were trained on “Patient Safety”. 88% of nurses passed with more than 70% marks. Nurses play a vital role in patient safety and as professionals who are with patients around the clock, nurses are positioned to prevent medication errors, ensure patients receive correct treatment and provide safeguards against problems

like falls etc. A small certificate distribution ceremony was held to appreciate the position holders.
