## CHIDLIFE WINS KE KHI AWARDS 2024

ChildLife has won the prestigious “**KHI AWARDS**” by K-Electric in the category of Public Health (*Secondary/Tertiary*) for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time in a row. This year, ChildLife has received the award for introducing **X-Ray and Computer Radiography (CR) in its children's Emergency Rooms (ER)** across Pakistan which helps the doctors in timely diagnoses and treatment.

## DIAGNOSTIC LAB SERVICES IN EMERGENCY ROOMS

ChildLife is now providing diagnostic lab services free of cost in its children's Emergency Rooms such as CBC, Electrolytes, Calcium, Blood gas, Serum Bilirubin, and Serum Creatinine.

**42,000 children** will get benefit through this initiative in each emergency room. This will not only help in prompt diagnosis but will also save the distressed parents from running pillar to post to have the tests conducted from outside.

**Every moment counts** in the Emergency Room when it comes to saving children's lives; this initiative will help accurately diagnose infections and metabolic electrolyte imbalances in children and provide them with the **right treatment**.



## BUILDING CAPACITY OF GOVERNMENT DOCTORS IN SECONDARY CARE HOSPITALS

ChildLife recently organized a **Pediatric Emergency Medicine (PEM) Boot Camp** in 5 Govt. tertiary care hospitals. The workshop was attended by **73 government doctors**: including 45 residents and 28 physicians working at District Headquarters Hospitals (DHQ), Taluka Hospitals (THQ), and Regional Health Centre (RHC) in Larkana, Nawabshah, Jamshoro, Hyderabad, Rawalpindi, Islamabad, and Peshawar.

The session covered broad spectrum of vital topics from pediatric emergency medicine, providing hands-on training in areas such as trauma, anti-rabies vaccination, airway management, anaphylaxis, poisoning, and helping babies breathe techniques. By addressing these critical areas, the training aimed to enhance the capacity of on-ground government doctors, equipping them with the skills necessary to meet the challenges encountered in the children's Emergency Rooms of public secondary care hospitals where ChildLife operates its telemedicine model.

This physician's network aims to be a dynamic learning platform, contributing to ChildLife's mission of providing standardized quality emergency care to children across public hospitals.
