ChildLife's 13<sup>th</sup> Children's Emergency Room (ER) has opened its door to the children of Multan. With a capacity to treat **150,000 children annually**, this **100-bed ER** spreads over **20,000 sq. ft.** and is the largest ER of ChildLife to date.

The upgraded ER boasts an improved infrastructure, equipped with life-saving equipment, a WHO-recommended triage assessment system, fully automated, well-stocked pharmacy, and 100+ trained staff to serve the children, not only from Multan but the whole province of Punjab, 24/7 and free of charge.

With every child being treated, we get one step closer to our vision of **making Pakistan child-safe.**

## SYNERGIES IN SUB-SPECIALITIES

In pursuit of **spreading the life-saving network** and reaching more children, ChildLife has signed an MOU with the **National Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases (NICVD)** to share best practices of our



Telemedicine Network and services with NICVD. This collaboration will help develop a mechanism where children reporting with cardiology issues will be consulted through telemedicine and referred to NICVD, when required.

Furthermore, we have also partnered with **Sindh Integrated Emergency & Health Services (SIEHS 1122)**. The partnership will enhance the capacity of the ambulance team to handle children's emergency during transportation. It will also evolve into live tele-consultations and addition of bubble CPAP machines in the ambulances.
