The latest research study by **US-based PALISI Global Health** highlights the exceptional quality of pediatric Emergency Rooms (ERs) in government hospitals operated by ChildLife Foundation. A one-year study (2021-2022) evaluated ERs at Civil Hospital, Karachi and Sheikh Zayed Children Hospital, Larkana.

The findings are remarkable: the mortality rate for critically ill children in these hospitals is just 1.2%, compared to an average of 6.3% across 46 sites in 19 low-income countries.

Healing with Compassion

Story of Sasui

Meet Sasui, a 3-month-old from Shikarpur who came to ChildLife-managed Emergency Room (ER) in Larkana as she was suffering from pneumonia.

Sasui's father, Bahadur, a farmer by profession, first took her to a private hospital in Shikarpur. Being from a humble background and a single provider for a family of 15 members, Bahadur was finding it difficult to afford his daughter's treatment at the private hospital. Following the doctor's recommendation, Bahadur rushed Sasui to ChildLife-managed ER in Larkana in a desperate race against time.

Sasui's illness had grown severe in the past days. When Bahadur first arrived at the ER, he had little hope that his daughter would recover. The ER staff, realizing Sasui's critical state immediately transferred her to the Resuscitation Room. The staff diagnosed her with severe pneumonia, conducted her blood tests, and administered respective doses of antibiotics to combat the infection.

After three hours of emergency care in Resus, Sasui's respiratory distress began to reduce. The staff then transferred her to ER's Step-Down area for further monitoring and treatment.

Bahadur was amazed by the compassion and kindness of the ER staff. "Injections, drips, medicines, and care flowed freely, without being asked for a single rupee" he expressed. "They gave my daughter a second chance to live."

In the face of adversity, the dedication and warmth of the ER staff brought hope and healing to a father and his precious daughter.
