

ChildLife establishes Coronavirus Risk Assessment Desks & Respiratory Critical Areas



In view of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, ChildLife Foundation has taken precautionary measures to deal with the suspected patients. Risk assessment desks and respiratory critical areas have been setup in all ChildLife Emergency Rooms across Sindh and Balochistan.

Risk Assessment Desks (RAD) have been created to identify patients with the suspicion of COVID- 19 and to isolate them from other patients so that further transmission of the virus can be avoided. After identification, patients are treated in isolated respiratory critical areas (red zone area) which are dedicated to catering emergencies related to COVID- 19. ChildLife doctors and nurses in red zone area are fully protected with PPE and follow the management of suspected patients through strict compliance of SOPs.

To date 3000+ children suspected of Corona have been referred to ChildLife special Triage Desk in ERs and of those, 20% are treated & advised testing as COVID-19 suspects and referred to screening spots by national health authorities.
