TELEMEDICINE PROJECT INAUGURATED AT NEW KARACHI HOSPITAL

The benefits include increased access particularly in rural areas, low cost of intervention, and high quality through senior doctors at remote site. Learnings from this pilot telemedicine project will help us replicate the model in government hospitals all over Pakistan for the benefit of the masses.

This amount will sponsor a block at ChildLife's 5th pediatric ER in Malir, and fund the South Florida Clinic in Machar Colony. The upcoming Children's ER at Malir Government Hospital will have four blocks (Triage, Resus, Pediatrics & Neonate) and will treat 150,000 children annually. This will be the 5th Children's ER by ChildLife inside government hospital in Karachi, increasing the capacity to treat 1 million children in ER annually.
