



Little Angel

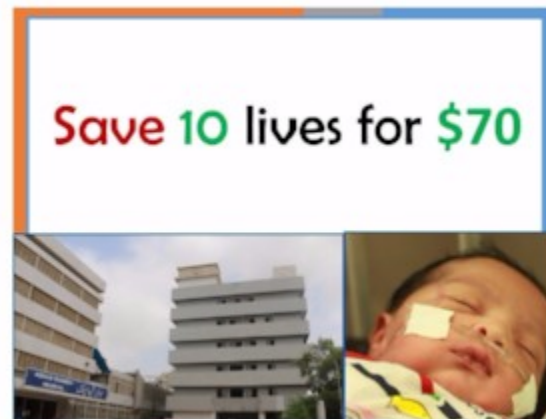
Salma's little angel was born at 6:15 am at a private hospital in Korangi, but within an hour and a half of her birth, she was rushed to the ChildLife Foundation's Pediatric Emergency Room at National Institute of Child Health by her grandmother as she was gasping. *"The doctors at the private hospital did not attend to the newly born and told me to take her to Civil or Jinnah to save her, as she had swallowed amniotic fluid. I left my daughter Salma crying for her baby and brought the little one here"* – said the grandmother.

"This is the first khushi of my daughter and we were all very worried. My grandchild was immediately given treatment here and I am much relieved to see that her condition is better now. Her breathing has also improved. I am glad that I have come to a place where my granddaughter received quality emergency care. The staff here speaks to me with concern and empathy. This is a very big thing for a distressed mother or grandmother like me. Salma is impatiently waiting for her child back at the private hospital. But the doctor says that the baby will be kept here under observation for some time. However, I know that by the Grace of Allah Almighty, I will be taking a healthy baby to my Salma's arms anxious to hold her little angel."



4th Children's Emergency Room at Abbasi Shaheed Hospital

September 11th, government signed an MoU with ChildLife Foundation for establishment & management of a new Children's Emergency Room at Abbasi Shaheed Hospital. This will be the 4th ChildLife ER in the city and is expected to treat 150,000 children annually. ChildLife has to date treated 1.6 million children in Children's ERs located at Civil Hospital, NICH, and Govt. Hospital Korangi. Abbasi Shaheed Hospital is the only tertiary care government hospital in heavily populated District Central, which means the parents in Nazimabad, North Nazimabad, Orangi, North Karachi, and Liaquatabad will soon have world class Children's ER in their neighborhood. The Hospital is named after Major Ziauddin Abbasi Shaheed who attained martyrdom on 11th September 1965 at Chawanda, Sialkot.

Teams from public sector hospitals in Larkana and Nawabshah visited our ER in Korangi. Drs. 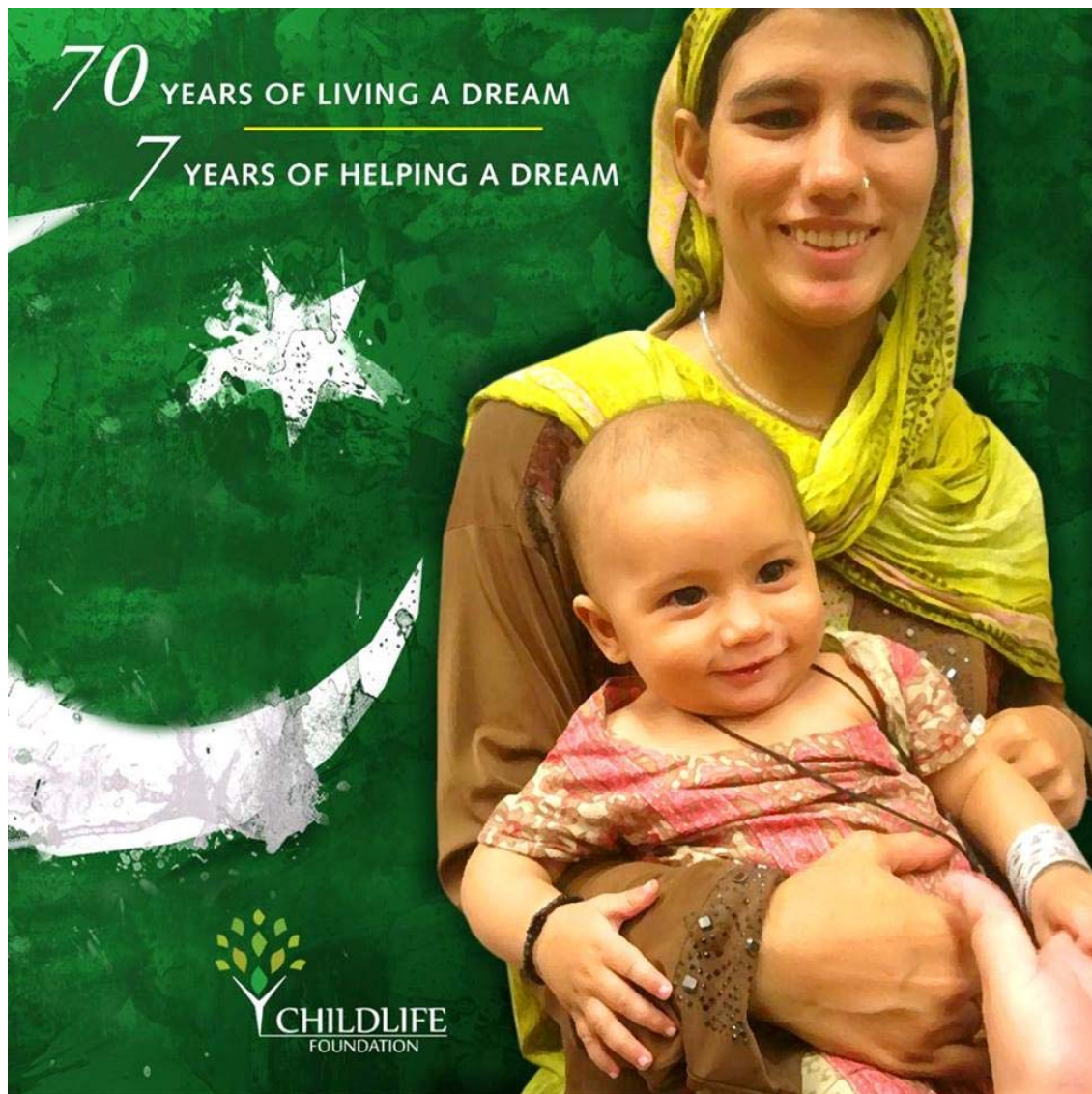
360 Degree Evaluation for Teamwork
