

Emergency Pediatric Care and Primary Care Clinics

Our Problem



- One child dies EVERY
 MINUTE in Pakistan
- Quality care is unaffordable for a poor family
- Existing facilities are not easily accessible
- Most causes of death are preventable

Our Solution



- Children in Pakistan at an imminent risk of life must have access to quality care
 - Facilitate and manage quality pediatric emergency rooms in public sector hospitals
 - Establish an accessible network of clinics for children in urban slums
 - Develop the capacity to provide critical preventive care to high risk children
 - Establish successful public-private partnerships

Our Achievements







- ChildLife Foundation (CLF) joined hands with the Government of Sindh to take over pediatric emergency care at the Civil Hospital (CHK), and National Institute of Child Health (NICH) in Karachi
- CLF is treating upto 1,000 children per day in both CHK and NICH pediatric emergency rooms
- CLF has trained all doctors in life-saving techniques including Pediatric Advanced Life Support, and it has improved the survival rate of critically ill children from 15% to 70%
- CLF has renovated and is managing five child care clinics established in urban slums to implement nutritional and immunization interventions at grass root level



- Stanford Emergency Medicine International (SEMI) is now a collaborating partner of CLF, focusing on manpower training, quality control and outcome research
- Between NICH, CHK and its five Child Clinics, CLF is providing quality lifesaving treatment to more than 400,000 children per year

Our Future Plans



- CLF is in the process of establishing Child Clinics in all 18 towns of Karachi. In the future, CLF plans to reach out across Pakistan with our partner, SINA Trust
- Most childhood diseases are preventable. CLF is initiating a Preventive Care Program in the heart of urban slums to tackle:
- Malnutrition
- Lack of immunization
- Poor access to safe drinking water
