We are humbled to share that ChildLife's children Emergency Room at Dr. Ruth Pfau Civil Hospital, Karachi is the first public sector's emergency room to be awarded the international SafeCare certification, achieving Level 5 status, reflecting the highest quality standards as per SafeCare's rigorous evaluation criteria.

SafeCare, an initiative by PharmAccess (Netherlands), Joint Commission International (JCI), and COHSASA, is a methodology with internationally accredited standards designed to enhance healthcare quality.

We remain steadfast in our commitment to maintaining these world-class standards, ensuring the best emergency care for every child, every time.



1st Urgent Care Center in Karachi is now Operational

Urgent Care Centers (UCCs) are designed to provide **immediate medical care** to critically ill patients. They ease the pressure from overwhelmed emergency rooms and are essential to ensure children with life-threatening conditions receive timely and specialized treatment.

Recognizing the pressing need for emergency care, ChildLife Foundation has established its first UCC at **Sindh Government Hospital, New Karachi**. Located in the under-served urban area of Karachi, the modernized UCC is equipped with 10 beds, life-saving equipment, an in-house pharmacy, and trained professionals to manage the operations 24/7 and save little lives.

With the capacity to **treat up to 20,000 children** annually, the UCC stands as a beacon of hope for underprivileged families of the region. This initiative reflects ChildLife's unwavering commitment to transforming emergency care for children, ensuring no child's life is lost due to lack of timely treatment.

One Year of Saving Lives in Multan

ChildLife's children Emergency Room (ER) in **Children's Hospital, Multan** has completed one year of dedicated service. The ER became operational in January 2024 and has **treated over 150,000 children**.

The major illnesses reported were:

- Pharyngitis
- Gastroenteritis
- Viral URTI
- Fever

The modernized ER is a 100-bed facility and boasts an improved infrastructure, 100+ trained staff, life-saving equipment, a fully stocked pharmacy, and in-house diagnostic and radiology services, ensuring provision of quality emergency treatment for the children of south Punjab, round-the-clock and free-of-cost.



Story of Khadija

For 5-year-old Khadija, it began with fever and difficulty breathing. Her mother, Fatima, thought it was a seasonal illness and tried medicines from a local clinic. However, instead of improving, Khadija's condition worsened with each passing day.

Frightened and desperate, Fatima and her husband rushed Khadija to the children's Emergency Room (ER) at Children Hospital, Multan, managed by ChildLife Foundation.

Upon arrival, Khadija was in severe respiratory distress. The ER team urgently shifted her to the resuscitation room, administered oxygen, IV medications, and conducting critical diagnostic tests to stabilize the little girl. Blood tests and a digital X-ray confirmed a diagnosis of bronchopneumonia.

Hours later, Khadija's condition improved, and Fatima could finally breathe a sigh of relief.

Overwhelmed with gratitude, Fatima shared, "I was terrified I might lose her, but the doctors and nurses at this ER saved my child's life. For mothers like me, who cannot afford private care, this place is a blessing beyond words."
