From Dusty Streets to Healing Hands: Anasiya's Story

In Sariab, Quetta, poor sanitation and dusty streets take a heavy toll on children's health. Nine-year-old Anasiya, the youngest of five, fell seriously ill with tonsillitis and high fever. With no means to afford private care, her family tried home remedies, but her condition worsened rapidly.

Rushed to the ChildLife-managed Children's Emergency Room at Sandeman Provincial Hospital, Quetta, Anasiya received immediate, life-saving care. Within hours of antibiotics and intensive monitoring, her fever subsided, her appetite returned, and hope was restored to her family.

Her father shared, *"Private hospitals were beyond our reach. ChildLife became a true ray of hope. They saved my daughter's life without asking for anything in return."*

Anasiya's story is a testament to ChildLife's mission: ensuring every child, regardless of background or location, has access to timely, free emergency care, and a fighting chance at life.
